

Risk Assessment - Ring The Rodeo Inflatable Game

Assessment Date: June 2026

ACTIVITY DESCRIPTION

Participants stand at the designated throwing point and throw a rubber ring towards a fixed inflatable bull target. The activity is a skill-based game and does not involve any moving or mechanical parts.

HAZARD CONTROL LOG

Hazard	Persons at Risk	Initial Risk	Residual Risk	Control Measures
Trips around the inflatable, blower, and cables	Participants, staff, spectators	Medium	Low	Keep the surrounding area clear. Route and cover electrical cables safely. Maintain good housekeeping around the site.
Slips, trips, and falls while throwing	Participants	Medium	Low	Ensure the playing surface is level, clean, and free from hazards. Players must throw from the designated flat surface.
Being struck by the rubber ring	Participants, spectators	Low	Low	Only one participant may throw at a time. Use only the supplied rubber rings. Spectators must stand back.
Collision with the inflatable	Participants	Low	Low	No climbing, jumping, or rough play on or around the inflatable. Provide a clear safety perimeter around the unit.
Inflatable collapse or movement	Participants, staff	High	Low	Inspect the inflatable before use. Ensure all anchor points are secure and the blower remains operating throughout use.
Adverse weather (outdoor use)	Everyone	High	Low	Do not operate during high winds or other severe weather. Close the attraction immediately if weather deteriorates.

Hazard	Persons at Risk	Initial Risk	Residual Risk	Control Measures
Manual handling during setup and dismantling	Staff	Medium	Low	The inflatable must only be set up, moved, and dismantled by trained staff members using correct lifting techniques.
Unauthorised or unsupervised use	Participants, public	Medium	Low	A responsible adult or trained operator must supervise the activity at all times while in use.
